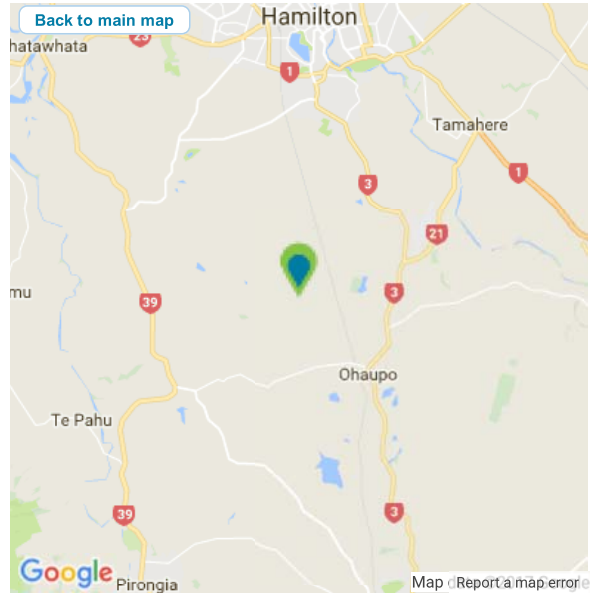
Improve lake water quality and restore and increase indigenous riparian margins of Lakes Milicich and Ngarotoiti and Henderson's Pond.

The purpose of this project is to improve lake water quality and restore and increase indigenous riparian margins of Lakes Milicich, Ngarotoiti and Henderson's Pond.

There are two main goals.

1. Improve water quality over the long term. Methods used will include:
 - Develop Peat Lake Management plans for all three lakes
 - Install 6 end-of-drain treatment systems by 2019
 - Ensure that all 3 lakes are 100 per cent stock excluded by 2018
 - Increase awareness and implementation of good management practice in the lake catchments and encourage landowners to increase their riparian lake margin to ensure a greater buffer between farmed land and the lake.
2. Restoring the indigenous vegetation by replacing exotic weeds with native wetland species.

This project received funding from the Waikato River Authority (WRA 16-005).
