The purpose of this one year project is for Maniapoto Māori Trust Board to provide facilitation processes to help whānau and hapū develop and test a tiaki taiao Cultural Health Indicator tool to implement on the Mangaokewa river.

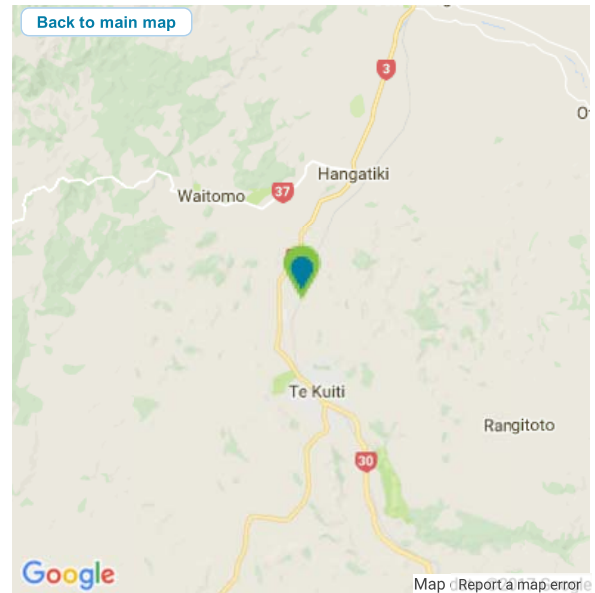
The goal of the project is to build whanau and hapu capacity and capability building to contribute to the restoration and protection of the health and wellbeing of the mauri of the river. The CHI tool will contribute to the Maniapoto Tiaki Taiao toolbox to support kaitiaki in the management of important mahinga kai areas and freshwater management.

Methods to undertake the project:

- the project planning workshop and implementation of the project will be facilitated by experienced project management person and technical experts
- the dissemination of information will be facilitated by experienced contractor and supported by whanau and hapu
- engage technical experts to undertake the development of the CHI tool and scope the tiaki taiao toolbox
- all fieldtrips on the Mangaokewa will be undertaken by experienced project management person and technical experts and whanau and hapu
- research and reports will be undertaken by University of Waikato graduate student and peer reviewed by experienced contractor.
