To develop science information into a tool that identifies the best planting solution for landowners

Our objective is to use a multidisciplinary analysis to distil the existing practical and scientific information into a tool for identifying the best planting solution for the unique characteristics of an individual site to remedy an identified issue.

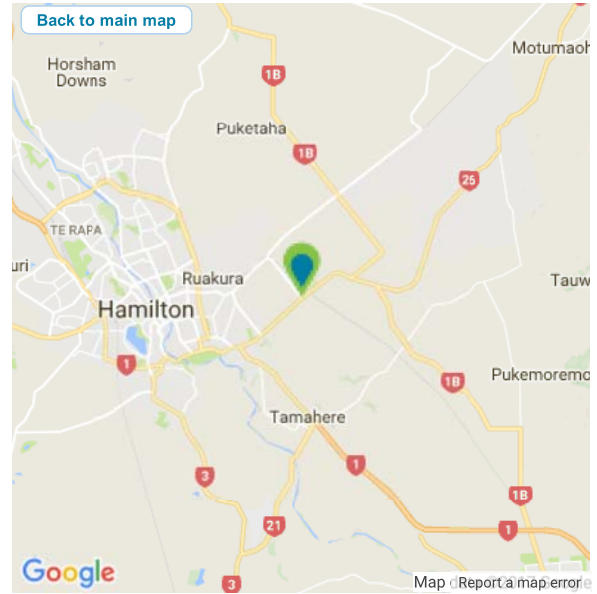
In the process of using the tool, a landowner will consider which of the key issues is of concern for each part of their watercourse, and can determine a unique selection of species that will be appropriate for the site to remedy the issue.

Rather than using matrix-type tools or reports, the envisaged end product will be a circular dialup card (known as a volvelle) in which the land owner can select the geographic location, soil type, land type (topography), existing vegetation cover, and the types of issues being faced on their watercourse.

One of the key aspects of this stage of the project involves a series of workshops with rural professionals.
