Project to fully protect and restore the Tangirua wetland.

This project is for Stage 1 of the Tangirau Wetland Restoration project.

The project purpose is to protect a significant wetland, increase indigenous flora and fauna diversity, improve in water quality, and increase amenity for the wider community. The goal is to fully protect and restore the Tangirua wetland and two other linked Significant Natural Areas.

Key tasks are: Fencing wetland margins to achieve physical protection, pest plant control, restoration of native vegetation where existing diversity is low while maintaining canopy cover to preserve habitat for significant indigenous fauna; A staged approach based on priority zones to accommodate the large size of the area and interest of landowners. The project will be completed in 3 stages. Stage 1 covers 43.3ha of area identified as top priority for restoration. Landowners within Stage 1 support the project.

This project received funding from the Waikato River Authority (WRA 16-002.)
