




TUWHARETOA ROHE

- Descendants of the Te Arawa waka
- 25 Marae makeup Tuwharetoa
- 5.3% of the Maori population
- a total of 35,877
 affiliated members
 (2013 Census)
- 80% of Ngāti
 Tuwharetoa live
 outside the tribal
 boundary.




RURAL MAORI LAND HOLDINGS





- In respect of public access, the Lake is managed by a collaborative governance Board.
- Crown own and operate the Lake Taupo trout fishery and the Lake Taupo harbour facilities.
- Right of first refusal over Crown assets and infrastructure.
- Commercial activities and new structures all require a licence to operate.


TE AWA O WAIKATO

- Polluted


