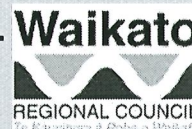

SUBMISSIONS ON SPECIFIC PROVISIONS OF PROPOSED PLAN CHANGE 2

Submission to Waikato Regional Council on behalf of Whakarawa Enterprises Ltd and Hauhungaroa Partnership

Whakarawa Enterprises Ltd and Hauhungaroa Partnership both farm properties inside the Lake Taupo Catchment on the Karangahape Road Peninsula.

Te Tumu Paeroa manage and lease land to Hauhungaroa Partnership on Karangahape Road.

The Overseer model utilising a long-term district average rain fall in its calculations. This disadvantages the NDA calculation on these properties significantly.

20 year rain fall records on the dairy farm of Hauhungaroa Partnership identify an average rainfall of close to 1,050 mls, 3 year rain fall average records at Whakarawa Enterprises Ltd identify an average rain fall of between 1,000 to 1,100 mls.

All three properties boundary each other.

The rainfall used in the Overseer Modelling is close to 1,400 mls and therefore disadvantages these properties significantly when entered into the Overseer Model.

The entities submission would like to see actual or more accurate rain fall data utilised which can be supplied along with livestock records, fertiliser records and other inputs required to complete the Overseer Modelling.

The overseer predicted leaching is significantly overstated with higher than actual rain falls recorded.

1. Trade competition
